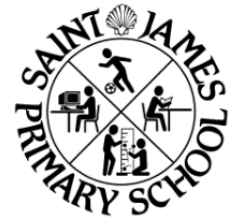

The whole school attendance for the year so far is 96%. Last week of term the following classes had attendance above 96%:

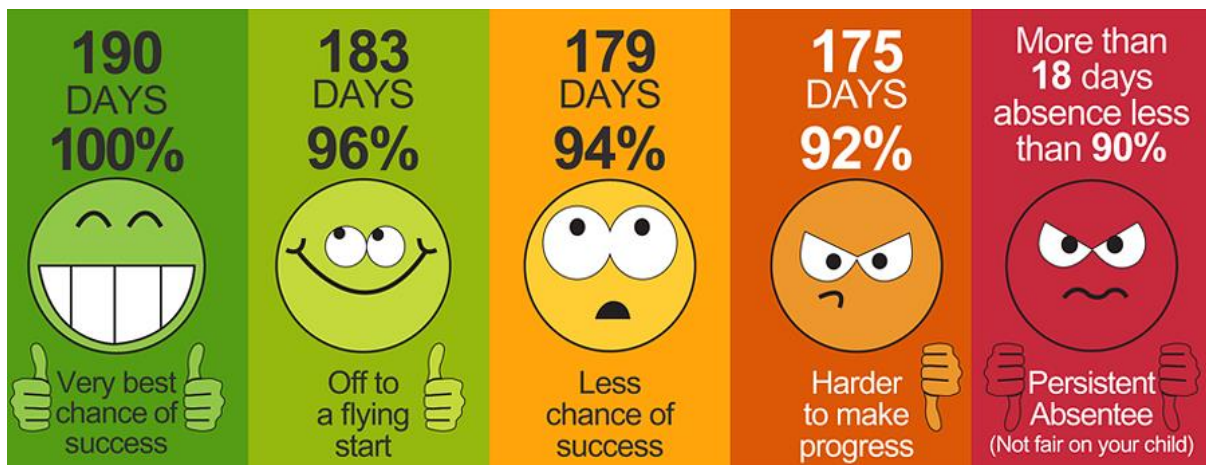
2J 98.67%, 2M 97.14%, 4C 96.90 5K 96.56%, 5M 96.21% 6M 97.23%, 6N 97.67%
