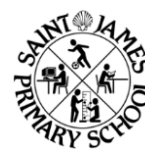

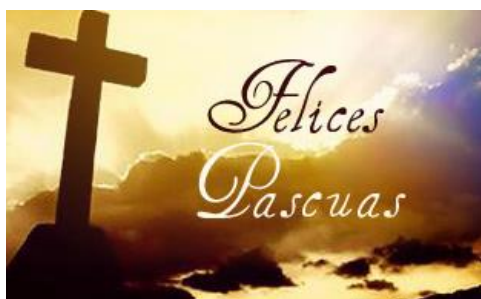


SCHOOL
